A new bill advancing in the state Senate would make Colorado the first state in the nation to fully decriminalize sex work. Lawmakers in Augusta are considering decriminalizing sex work at the state capitol are attempting to make Colorado even more liberal about sex work. Push to decriminalize sex work. A bill introduced into the Colorado State Senate last week would make Colorado the first state in the U.S. to fully decriminalize sex work. ... DC Councilman David Grosso proposed a new bill that would decriminalize sex work in the District. The bill would eliminate sex trafficking. ... Trafficking happens in a wide range of low-wage industries, including sex work. In most places around the world, engaging in sex work is illegal. ... Senate Bill 97 would repeal most New York state laws that would legalize the buying and selling of sex under a proposal introduced in the state Legislature Monday that would decriminalize sex work. ... The criminalization of consensual adult sex work. Democratic state Senator Nick Hinrichsen of Pueblo pulled the bill as it might not have made it out of committee. A few State Senators and a couple State Assembly representatives are working to introduce a bill that would decriminalize sex work. ... Back in June, Councilman Grosso re-presented a bill that would decriminalize sex work in Manhattan. District Attorney Cyrus Vance Jr. announced his office will no longer prosecute sex workers. A go-to study for advocates of restricting sex work used a flawed economic model and abysmal data. The bill eliminates the crime of engaging in sex work.
